
Art Show Gallery

TIME WITH TAMMY







Summer Reminders

- <u>PROJECT REQUEST FORMS</u> If you are looking to do some updating to your home please remember that projects require to be signed off on by Fairlawn before beginning. Examples are: Adding a garden box out back, storm door replacements, flag poles, major landscape changes, patio expansions, interior painting, and flooring replacement. Project Request forms are available in Darin's office.
- <u>WATER SPIGOTS</u> please be mindful this summer as you water plants or trees to not let your water spigot run. Anyone using excessive amounts of water are subject to additional surcharges.
- <u>AIR CONDITIONING</u> If you are running your AC, try to keep your windows closed to be most efficient.
- <u>USDA DUMPSTERS</u>-Do not leave trash on the ground or next to the Dumpster-It will not be picked up. These Dumpsters are for USDA Residents only.
- <u>LANDSCAPE TRIMMING</u> will begin in early June to touch up the shrubs so they are beautiful for the summer!

Tornado Preparedness

As we come into Tornado Season we want to offer a few recommendations to be prepared.

<u>When a tornado watch or warning has been</u> issued seek shelter at the following locations:

- Duplex Resident: one of the 11 duplexes with a basement
- USDA: the most inner room of your apartment or one of the 11 duplexes with a basement
- Haven Apartment: the inner hallway or one of the 11 duplexes with a basement
- Wyse Commons: the men's restroom or one of the 11 duplexes with a basement

Recommendations for Severe Weather Alerts:

• Download the FEMA App to receive real-time weather alerts.


